## **SWIMMING POOL RULES**

- Maximum occupancy 70
- It is a Whatcom County Health Department requirement that when the pool is used by children 14 years of age or under, that a responsible adult, 18 years or older, must accompany the children and be in the pool area <u>AT ALL TIMES!</u>
- Persons ages 15-17 must be accompanies by a "swim buddy," the same age or older at all times.
- No one should swim alone.

## SINCE THE POOL HAS NO LIFEGUARD, THE ABOVE RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED AND MUST BE FOLLOWED!

- A shower is to be taken by all persons planning to enter the pool BEFORE swimming.
- No running or horseplay is allowed in the pool.
- No person with a communicable disease or illness is to use the pool.
- No one under the influence of alcohol or drugs is to use the pool.
- No food or drinks are allowed in the pool area at any time.
- No glass containers are allowed in the pool area.
- Homeowners are responsible for the conduct of their renters and/or guests.
- Infants/toddlers MUST wear approved swim diapers, or they are not allowed in the pool.
- Sharp edged, pointed, or metal pool toys are not allowed in the pool.
- Rocks and stones are not to be used as diving toys.
- Oversized pool toys are not allowed. Only approved pool toys are allowed in the pool.
- Animals are not allowed in the pool area at any time.
- Smoking is not allowed in the pool area at any time.
- The phone on the wall in the pool area is for emergencies only
- No diving is allowed in the pool.

The Board of Directors wants to ensure that everyone has an enjoyable time at the pool. The above rules must be followed, as bad behavior by any homeowner or their guest(s) will not be tolerated. Anyone not following these rules will have their pool key card suspended.

Homeowners whose dues are not current are not eligible to use the pool. This applies to renters and guest(s) also.
